



The last 2 years has been a roller coaster ride. However, we have been working hard so we can come back bigger and better while at the same time creating new opportunities for you, the cowboys and cowgirls. In February 2021, the **BPIR** announced a partnership with the **PBR** (Professional Bull Riding) organization, which will create some new opportunities for both organizations as they work together on various projects, such as Showdown in Vegas in June of this year.

I am sure you have seen our promotions concerning the **Dual Paths**. The Dual Paths refers to the fact that to get to the **2022 BPIR National Finals** you have two different series to compete in. One path is the BPIR Texas Connection Series which will consist of 4 rodeos in Ft. Worth at the Ft. Worth Stockyard Coliseum and then the BPIR Legacy Series that travels to Denver, California, and Atlanta.

In addition to the Dual Paths, we have made some other changes concerning membership, rodeo entry and opportunities for the BPIR rodeos that you compete in to count towards some huge opportunities in the **WCRA** and the **PBR**.

BPIR has become a Silver Alliance Partner with the **WCRA**, which will create opportunities for you in 2022. What does this partnership mean for you? It means that if you want your BPIR rodeo points to count towards the **WCRA**, you can nominate during the BPIR entry process. If you nominate the BPIR event, you will receive:

- 10% discount on Nomination cost
- **WCRA** Alliance Consolation and **VRQ** Expanded Points to 10th place
- **WCRA** Triple Crown Event and Women's Rodeo World Championship Event Nomination Opportunity

As part of our partnership with the **WCRA**, at the end of the Ft. Worth Rodeo in May, the BPIR lady contestants will receive an exemption into the 2022 Women's Rodeo World Championship in May 2022. The highest placing BPIR Lady Barrel Racer and Lady Break Away contestant, which have nominated the BPIR events from January to May, will receive an invite into 2022 Women's Rodeo World Championship Round 1 competition.

The **WCRA** will use BPIR Rodeo Series Points to qualify (points and leaderboard provided by **WCRA**). This will be a running point tally of



those cowgirls who have nominated **LBR** or **LBA** discipline at multiple BPIR rodeos from January to May. The Guaranteed Purse for the Women's Rodeo World Championship is \$750,000.00.

Also in 2022, at the end of our BPIR National Finals in September, those who have nominated BPIR rodeos throughout the year in the following disciplines (Bareback, Bull Riding, Steer Wrestling, Tie-Down Roping, Women's Barrel Racing and Women's Breakaway Roping) through the **WCRA** can be invited to the **WCRA** Cowtown Christmas Champion Rodeo in December. The **WCRA** will Use BPIR Rodeo Series Points to qualify (points and leaderboard provided by **WCRA**). This will be a running point tally of those who have nominated that discipline at BPIR events for the year. The nominated leader in the series points for the disciplines at the conclusion of the BPIR Finals event will earn the invite. The Added Money for the **WCRA** Cowtown Christmas Champion Rodeo is \$360,000.00.

Once again huge opportunities for you to participate in some large money rodeos. Start thinking about how you will take advantage of the new opportunities and start educating yourself about the **WCRA** nomination process.

In addition, we have also created a point opportunity with the **PBR** for the BPIR Bull Riders. The winners at a BPIR rodeo event can earn **PBR** points towards the **PBR** standings if they are a **PBR** member and place in the top five spots at a BPIR rodeo. BPIR contestants will receive **PBR** points (if they are a **PBR** member) based on their placement. **PBR** points are awarded based on placement using a 5,4,3,2,1 scale. For example, if BPIR contestants win first and second and are not **PBR** members and another contestant that is a **PBR** member wins third, then the 3rd contestant winner would receive 3 points towards the **PBR** standings. Remember, **PBR** Points are awarded based on where you finish in the BPIR event for the 5 top spots, and you must be a **PBR** member to participate in this opportunity.

As you see a lot of new opportunities. In addition, I am very excited to announce that we will be adding a third ladies' event (Ladies Break Away) to our shows this year. Ladies get ready to show your stuff in Ladies Break Away and to take advantage of the additional opportunities to nominate the BPIR rodeo for points with the **WCRA**.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

To compete in a BPIR Rodeo and to make into the BPIR National Finals you must be a BPIR member. Each member has to complete the BPIR membership package including the W9 for IRS reporting. All paperwork will be completed online which allow you to do an electronic signature. We ask that you please complete your paperwork with your legal name that your Social Security number is associated with. All paperwork must be complete in its entirety before you are allowed to pay your membership fees.

Membership fees for BPIR in 2022 will be \$100.00 and you will be able to start the membership process on **Friday, November 5, 2021.**

HOW TO BECOME A MEMBER

1. Go to **www.billpickettrodeo.com**, click on **Contestants/Membership**
2. **Membership button** that will take you to all paperwork (Application Bio, Release etc.) which needs to be completed and signed. Once paperwork is completed, then it will take you to the next step to pay your membership fees.
3. **Once fees are paid**, you will be provided a membership number. *Please write it down and keep it because you will need it when you enter a BPIR rodeo.*



RODEO ENTRY

The BPIR entry process has been upgraded and we will be using the same entry system that the IPRA, WCRA and other associations use.

Using this system requires that all rodeo entries must be done online using the **RET system**. To enter a BPIR rodeo you just have to go to our website and go to the **Contestants header**. When you click on it, you will see a drop down that says **Rodeo Entry**. Click on it and it will take you to the **RET system**.

To use the RET system, you will have to register for an RET account. To do that, it will ask for your email and require you to create a password.

Select the Account Type and enter your name, birthday, phone number and your main rodeo discipline. For more information you can go to <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WhzZZuMdwdw&t=12s> to watch a video on How to create an Account on RET

Once you have established an account, you can enter a BPIR rodeo using RET once the books are open.

I encourage you to go and set up your RET account now, so that when we open the books in December for MLK, you are ready to go.

HOW TO ENTER A BPIR RODEO

1. Go to www.billpickettrodeo.com, click on Rodeo Entry. It will take you to the RET system
2. Register an account with RET or if you already have an account, sign in to RET
3. Now you are Ready to enter a rodeo. See How to Enter video link for more details if needed. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=uV3s93uo034&t=16s>
4. Don't forget to nominate the BPIR rodeo if you want your points to count towards the WCRA when entering a specific BPIR Rodeo.



Let me share information that I know you want to know:

Remember there are absolutely **NO WALK UPS**. Everyone must enter through the **RET** system within the open registration period. Once the registration is closed, no new entries will be accepted or refunds made. The call-in schedule is as follows:

BPIR 2022 ONLINE ENTRY DATES

Entries for all BPIR Rodeos will open according to the dates below and will closed 2 weeks prior to each rodeo scheduled.

Once books are closed, **"NO WALK UP's WILL BE TAKEN"**.

Online entry starts **December 1, 2021** and will be open until **January 5, 2022**.

MLK draw to be completed and posted by; **Monday January 10, 2022** via BPIR Facebook page.

FT. WORTH, TX. FEBRUARY 19, 2022

Online entry starts **January 19, 2022** and will be open until **February 9, 2022**.

Draw to be completed and posted by **February 14th** via BPIR Facebook page.

FT. WORTH, TX. MAY 13 & 14, 2022

Entry starts **April 13, 2022** and will be open until **May 4, 2022**.

Draw to be completed and posted by **May 9, 2022** via BPIR Facebook page.

Please note that this rodeo will be Televised and will be a progressive rodeo. The top 10 from the slack and Friday event will participate in the Saturday night performance.

Entry starts **May 18, 2022** and will be open until **June 8, 2022**.

Top 10 will be notified by **August 31, 2022**.

Invitation to the BPIR Finals will be sent on **August 31, 2022** and all invitees in Group 1 and 2 must be paid by **Friday, September 9, 2022 by 10:00 CST** to secure your spot. Any spots that need to be filled by Group 3 will be notified on **September 9, 2022** and must be paid by **September 11, 2022** by midnight to secure spot.



Let me share information that I know you want to know:

RELAY RACING:

Relay Racers must enter at the event. Relay Racers must have all paperwork completed and team fee paid at least 2 hours before the 1st Performance on any rodeo.

SANCTIONED RODEOS:

BPIR will not be sanctioning any rodeos in 2022.

MEMBERSHIP PAPERWORK AND W9S

All new members must complete the BPIR membership package including the W9 for IRS reporting. Please complete your paperwork with your legal name that your Social Security number is associated with when completing the paperwork. You may be asked for identification to validate information

RENEWAL MEMBERS will only have to complete a renewal membership sheet with current contact information and a W9 for IRS reporting. Please provide your legal name that your Social Security number is associated with when updating your paperwork.

UPDATED BPIR RULE BOOK

The updated rule book will be posted on our website under the Contestants icon and available for you to review at any time. There is a section added to the Rule Book that is identified as Rule Change. Any changes or new rules added to the rule will be captures under the addendum section.

Payoff scale will remain the same in 2020. See below

The BPIR Finals payoff scale will be announced each year once the finals added money is determined.

NO WALK UPS – This remain the same. Everyone must call in. See call-in schedule below.



SHOWDOWN IN VEGAS

If there is a Showdown in Vegas in 2022, it will be in either October or November and the top ten who competed at the BPIR finals will be invited to the 2022 Showdown in Vegas.

BPIR EVENT DIRECTORS

Directors are responsible for making sure the event rules are being followed and must be at the rodeo early enough to complete the directories' responsibilities.

Directors are responsible for the following items if applicable to their event:

- Assist in marking or staking the arena
- Locate the 4 barrels
- Remove/replace barrel covers
- Run cattle through
- Identify lame or defective stock and cut from rodeo
- Identify stock number and provide information to rodeo secretaries
- Address event issues and engage Judges or Rodeo management team when appropriate.
- Directors are expected to be at each rodeo
- If a director cannot attend a rodeo, they are responsible for notifying the Alternate to assure alternate will be in attendance. Director should advise the secretary as soon as possible they will not be in attendance and Alternate will be performing job duties.
- If Alternate is also unable to attend, the director must notify one of the rodeo secretaries immediately, who will notify Wefus Tyus. Wefus is then responsible for identifying an acting director for that specific rodeo.

BPIR Rules & Regulations 2022

In 2022 BPIR will operate using its own rules as outlined in the BPIR Rule book, which is online.

There is an Icon under the Rule Book section called **RULE CHANGES** to captures any rule changes or new rules added to the Rule Book as an easy reference for you.

There are a number of changes, and I am highlighting a few that you should be aware of. The changes below are not an inclusive list but just a few major changes:

- BPIR will continue to abide by its own rules in 2022.
- Membership cards must be purchased to participate in any BPIR rodeo.

Membership cards are \$100.00 for 2022.

Seniors - 50 years and above must purchase a membership the 1st year for \$40. All memberships are free afterwards as long as they have 2 years of consecutive participation.

- All members entry must be paid 2 weeks before the scheduled rodeo. If not paid timely, you will not be allowed on the books once they have been closed.

Please read carefully because there will be no exceptions for members or non- members. Once the books are closed, they are closed for everyone.



QUALIFYING FOR THE 2022 BILL PICKETT INVITATIONAL FINALS RODEO - TOP 10

TOP 10:

To qualify for the BPIR Finals a participant must compete in one (1) more than 1/2 of BPIR rodeos prior to the BPIR Finals.

In 2022, there are a total of 8 BPIR rodeos, so to make it to the finals you must compete in 5 rodeos. Please note to qualify for the BPIR National Finals, you must participate in a minimal of 3 rodeos from the BPIR Texas Connections Series and a minimal of 2 rodeos from the BPIR Legacy Series.

The top 10-point (money) leaders who are BPIR members and have met the rodeo requirement rule of (one more than half) will qualify for BPIR National Finals Rodeo. The top 10 leaders in each event will be invited to compete in the finals for that event.

PLEASE NOTE: The BPIR Finals does not count as a qualifying rodeo.

If a BPIR member competes in two or more events during the current rodeo year, they qualify for All-Around Cowboy/Cowgirl competition. However, mere qualification alone does not guarantee a spot in both events at the finals. For example, if a contestant is NOT one of the top 10 leaders in one of their events, they may not be a BPIR finalist in that event merely because they competed in a second event and/or won money in that event. Monies won in each event will count towards All-Around Cowboy/Cowgirl points.

If a contestant is invited to compete at the BPIR National Finals as an alternate and DID NOT compete in one more than half of the rodeos, he/she WILL NOT be eligible for any year-end awards, however anyone who competes will be eligible for Bill Pickett Invitational Rodeo Finals awards. i.e. average event winners. To be eligible for a BPIR Championship title, you must compete in the BPIR Finals.

Please note, Contestants will be grouped according to how they qualify to compete at the finals as follows:

- ONLY Group 1 (Qualified Rodeo requirements & earned money) will be eligible for Year End Awards and finals entry fee will be paid by BPIR.
- Group 2 (Qualified Rodeo requirements & No Money) will be considered Alternates
- Group 3 (Money & Not Enough Qualified Rodeos) will be considered Alternates.

BPIR FINALS JACKETS:

All contestants competing at the finals will receive a BPIR Finals jacket.



RFKS ENTRY RULE:

All timed events (CR, SW, LSU) are last to ENTER first to go EXCEPT Ladies Barrel Racing. All CONTESTANTS and STAFF must check in with Secretary on day of event to receive credentials and back numbers.

BPIR Rules & Regulations 2022 *continued*

STALLS AND RV HOOK-UPS:

Contestants, Staff and Specialty Acts are responsible for paying their Stall, RV's and Electrical Hook-up Charges in each market. If anyone leaves a market without paying their charges, they will not be allowed to enter another BPIR rodeo until all charges are paid.

RELAY RACE RULE:

All Relay teams MUST registered and paid with the secretary 2 hours prior to the rodeo. If there are any changes to your team members, you must notify the secretary before competing in order to avoid disqualification.

If there is (7) Relay Teams or Less, Each team will run both days

(SAT & SUN) and both Performances (1:30 & 7:30) and paid on an AVERAGE of the combined times. If there is (8) or more teams, the relay race will be ONE RUN based on FASTEST TIMES. The Teams will be divided based on ODD Numbers running on (SATURDAY or 1:30) Performance and EVEN numbers running on (Sunday or 7:30PM Performance).

In the event the Rodeo only has one performance, the odd numbers will compete in the (pre-show or 1st session) and the even numbers will compete in the (2nd session). The Relay pattern will be stakes prior to competing in a one run competition.

* Each contestant will be allowed to compete on TWO TEAMS ONLY.

If a person is found to have competed on more the TWO TEAMS, ALL the teams will be DISQUALIFIED. ALL THREE TEAMS will be disqualified, and NO MONEY will be REFUNDED.

Relay Race operates as follows:

1. THE START OF THE RELAY WILL BEGIN AT THE FIRST BARREL AND THE FINISH WILL BE AT THE FIRST BARREL (reason: the majority of the relay racers will be accustomed to starting at the 1st barrel and stopping at the 4th. The relay racers are generally the same group of people each year.
2. THE PASSING OF THE BATON WILL OCCUR BETWEEN THE 4TH AND 1ST BARREL ONLY (i.e. the pass can't happen at the 4th, nor can it. The passing of the baton will occur between the 4th and 1st barrel only (i.e. The pass can't happen at the 4th, nor can it happen at the 1st, it must be between the barrels).
3. You have to be ready to enter the arena when your team is called, if not, you will be disqualified and will forfeit your entry fee.
4. You can encourage your horse to run; however, the designated relay baton is all that you can pass between riders.
5. The barrel will be staked at the very beginning and will remain the same for the duration of the race for both performances.

LADIES BARREL RACING:

The ladies barrel race will be ONE run with 16 or more called in and paid contestants. Two runs with (1-15) called in and paid entries.

BAREBACK EVENT

As everyone knows, over the last couple of years we have struggled to get a reputable number of bareback riders to participate at BPIR rodeos. There has been a lot of conversation about eliminating the event in 2022 season. However, after much discussion, the BPIR has decided to retain the event but with the following requirements:

- The Added Money will be adjusted to reflect the participation
- There must be a minimal of 5 paid contestants for the event to take place by the close of books. If there are not 5 paid contestants when the books close, entries will be refund to those paid and the event will be eliminated for that particular rodeo.

TIMED EVENTS:

For timed events, the contestant has 3 attempts to set their animal to contest their stock. After the 3rd attempt, the Judge will allow 45 seconds before your stock is released.

ROOKIE OF THE YEAR QUALIFICATIONS:

To be eligible for Rookie of the year, a participant must compete in one (1) more than 1/2 of BPIR rodeos including sanctioned rodeos in an event.

A Rookie contender must have a membership card and have not participated previously as a BPIR member.

GROUND MONEY:

If there is no qualified score or time in an event, the ground money will not count toward points.

BULL RIDING PAY OUTS:

Bull Riding will be paid on each go round per rodeo. BPIR Finals will pay each go round and an average

COGGINS REQUIRE:

Current Coggins Papers (No Exceptions) Please have your papers available for each rodeo if case you are asked for them.

BOOKS CLOSE:

* In 2022, Book will close two weeks prior to each rodeo according to schedule above. All entries must be done online.



BPIR Rules & Regulations 2022 *continued*

BPIR PERMITS:

In 2022, only local permits will be allowed in California and Atlanta rodeos.

- Non-members locals will only be allowed to entered the Oakland, CA., Los Angeles, CA. and Atlanta, GA. Rodeos. Locals must purchase permits online at the time the entry fee is paid. They will also be required to send proof of current identification to verify that they meet local entry qualifications.
- If a Permit Holder earns money during a rodeo, and elects to purchase a membership during payoff the cost of membership is one hundred dollars (\$100.00) less the twenty five dollars (\$25.00) permit fee or seventy five dollars (\$75.00). Points (earnings) won under a permit will not count towards the standings. Points earned under the newly purchased membership will begin to count at the next BPIR Rodeo with money earned.
- Local Permit holders will not be eligible for any prizes other than money earned at BPIR rodeos in which permit holder participates. Permit holders will not be eligible for finals.
