

## **BPIR 2026 Season Mulligan Policy**

Due to the strict timelines and requirements for Bill Pickett Invitational Rodeo members, and in recognition of our participants' busy schedules, BPIR will offer a one-time mulligan for the 2026 season. Mulligans becomes effective the date of your membership and cannot be rolled over to the next year or transferred.

A "mulligan" allows a member who has missed a registration entry and/or payment deadline to receive one penalty-free opportunity to complete their registration requirements for that event. It also allows member/participant to use it in Drawing out after the deadline. The Mulligan does not result in disqualification, penalties or late fees. The mulligan must be used within specified timeframes:

- **Entry/Registration** – You can use your Mulligan after the original entry deadline up to 24 hours after the Draw is posted to enter.
- **Draw Out** - You can use your Mulligan 24 hours after the official draw out time has expired according to the rule book.

### **Mulligan Guidelines:**

- Limited to one (1) mulligan per participant for the entire 2026 season. Mulligans cannot be rolled over or transferred.
- Mulligan can be used but must be requested by contacting Stephanie Haynes
- Does not excuse participants from meeting all other BPIR rules and rodeo requirements
- This does not exempt participants from adhering to all other BPIR rules and rodeo requirements.

Participants are strongly encouraged to meet all original deadlines. The mulligan policy is intended as a one-time courtesy for our contestants, not a substitute for timely registration or draw out requirements.
